

## AI-Based Day Trading: How It Works + Platform Comparison

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### What Is AI-Based Day Trading?

**AI-based day trading** refers to the use of artificial intelligence (AI) or algorithmic systems to make trading decisions—automatically placing buy and sell orders without human intervention—**based on pre-set rules or strategies** provided by either the trader or the platform operator.

This approach is increasingly used by both professionals and retail traders to:

- Monitor price movements in real time
- React faster than humans to signals
- Eliminate emotional decision-making
- Capitalize on short-term market fluctuations

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### How It Works: Step by Step

#### 1. Human-defined General Rules

You or the platform operator defines the “boundaries” of what the AI can and cannot do. These might include:

- What assets to trade (e.g., only S&P 500 stocks, or just BTC/USDT)
- When to trade (e.g., 9:30 AM – 3 PM only)
- Maximum drawdown or loss allowed
- Technical triggers (e.g., RSI < 30 AND MACD crossover)
- Risk/reward ratio, leverage limits, position sizes

#### 2. AI/Algorithmic Engine Executes

Within those rules, the AI:

- Monitors markets in real time
- Analyzes technical patterns, indicators, volume spikes, and even sentiment
- Opens trades automatically
- Sets and adjusts stop-loss and take-profit levels
- Closes positions based on exit logic or new risk conditions

Some systems run entirely autonomously, while others allow human approval before execution.

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### Typical Operator Instructions (Examples)

Operators can instruct the AI using structured or natural logic:

- “Only enter a long trade if volatility is below X and RSI is above Y.”
- “No trading before or after major news announcements.”
- “If a trade goes 10 pips in profit, move the stop loss to breakeven.”
- “Exit all trades by 3:50 PM to avoid overnight exposure.”

Platforms that support natural-language input (like **Capitalise.ai**) even allow these instructions in plain English.

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### Advantages of AI-Based Day Trading

#### Pros

24/7 execution without fatigue  
No emotion, pure logic

Overfitting to past data can mislead AI
