PLURALITY-BASED U.S. GOVERNING SYSTEM IN THE DIGITAL AGE: A DECENTRALIZED, DIRECT DEMOCRACY MODEL WITH SECURE DIGITAL PARTICIPATION

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We suggest to develop and gradually introduce a modern, plurality-based governing system in the US within the existing Constitution of the United States of America. Each part of the system presented below includes a section, "Why This Works Without a Major Constitutional Change."

1. EXECUTIVE BRANCH: DISTRIBUTED PRESIDENTIAL POWER

*To eliminate single-party dominance while ensuring efficiency, the **executive branch** is restructured into a decentralized leadership system.*

Key Changes:

- **Executive Decision Council (EDC):**
 - Replaces the single President with a **five-member executive leadership team**.
