

## IDF: PLUG UP IRANIAN NUKES

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### October 10, 2024 – The Appeal to IDF

Nearly a year ago, I issued a clear and specific appeal to the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) on X:  
*“Disable Iranian underground nuclear facilities using conventional precision-guided bombs to destroy their electricity access points—their lifeline. Follow up with continuous monitoring of the entry points. U.S. earth-penetrating munitions, and approval, are not required, although welcome.*

*“IDF, —plug up Iran’s nukes!”*

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### October 12, 2025 – Follow-Up by Fire?

Twelve months and two days later, the skies above Iran reportedly lit up with coordinated strikes targeting deep underground nuclear infrastructure. Coincidence? Maybe. But allow me this half-serious observation: they followed up on my appeal—to the letter. And very effectively. Initial satellite analysis and local reports point not to flattened buildings, but rather to pinpointed destruction of surrounding infrastructure—particularly entry tunnels, access points, and utility corridors. Power was cut. Surface structures, curiously, were left largely intact. It’s almost as if the IDF understood that the most effective way to kill a buried organism is to suffocate it, not to smash its ribcage. So... did Israel actually *plug* up Iran’s nukes?

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### The Strategic Message

Whether intended or not, the Israeli action may have delivered a deeper message—not just to Iran, but to every aspiring nuclear state on the economic periphery:

**"If you bury your nukes underground, we'll bury them with you."**

No need for massive air campaigns. No need for regime change. Just a surgical sealing operation—high-tech, bloodless, and strategically irreversible.

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
